
# Call for Participation: VoIP Emergency Services Workshop

### A simple idea...

- Enable emergency calling for Voice-over-IP
  - 9-1-1, 1-1-2, 1-1-1, 9-9-9, etc.
- Two main steps:
  - Figure out where the caller is
  - Find out the responsible emergency authorities



#### ... complex to implement

- Emergency calling systems are implemented differently around the world
  - Different technical arrangements
  - Different regulatory constraints
  - To support VoIP fully, need a solution that is as global as the Internet
- Multiple stakeholders need to participate

#### **Emergency Services Workshops**

- Bring together many stakeholders to coordinate development of VoIP emergency systems
  - Networks: AT&T, Verizon, BT, DT, ...
  - Equipment vendors: Cisco, Nokia-Siemens, ...
  - Regulators: US FCC, EC Info. Society, ...
  - Standards organizations: IETF, 3GPP, OMA, IEEE, ...
- Lots of participation from US, EU in the past
- Strong need for Asian participation
